Offshore

We have flown many interesting projects doing this season which required us to think out of the box. Covid-19 has added to the complexity of the planning phase of a mission where finding and complying with the local restrictions is not always simply done. But when airborne, flying has never been more satisfying. The sky is empty and it is much easier to get permission by Air Traffic Controllers to enter usual busy airspaces.

We have managed to complete several missions in new regions of Europe such as our whale counting project Bay of Biscay in France. This project involved a

close cooperation with the French and Spanish authorities as the project was located far from shore. On our way to Spain Covid-19 was visible from the air and the main beaches, highways and public places in Europe now looked completely abandoned.

2020 has in many ways been a hectic year in our offshore department and at this point it seems like 2021 will give us even more work despite the Covid-19 outbreak – Work which we welcome with open arms!

Safety first

During this season, several initiatives have been implemented.

Our new manual regarding procedures on the ground and in our hangar have created a safer and more effective work environment and made it easier to ensure a good start for our newly assigned pilots.

New procedures concerning numbering of headsets, face-mask usage and seat separation onboard the aircraft has been put into effect due to Covid-19.

In November I invited all our pilots

to a fire and rescue course and I'm happy to announce that everyone passed with great results. In the unlikely event of a fire onboard I'm confident that the top tuned pilot we have provided to you will be able to extinguish flawless.

With a mix of experience and research, we constantly work on optimizing our procedures to ensure the safety is on point.

New regulations have been implemented from the Danish government which allows us as a company to Covid test our personnel and have the test result provided. This will now be implemented in Bioflight, so all our pilots will be tested before expatiation.

Our new Flagship

In 2020 we received our new flagship OY-VPS, a Vulcanair P68 Observer 2 with more advanced equipment such as Garmin 1000 and TCAS - traffic collision avoidance system. The aircraft is intended for offshore production and painted in a special shark coding. On the tail you will find "The little mermaid" which is one of the most known icons in Denmark. The TCAS software will detect all traffic in a radius of 40nm around the aircraft. This will increase the pilot situation awareness and thereby significantly enhance the safety onboard.
